Wycombe Race

Wycombe skiers made the best of their home advantage to take the top 3 male and 2 of the top 3 female places in the 3rd L&SERSA race of the series held at Wycombe Summit on Sunday 27th July. Fastest male skiers of the day were **Marc Telling (1st)**, **Andrew Rowe (2nd)** and **Paul Telling (3rd)** all from Wycombe. **Nicola Wilson** from Chatham took first female place, with **Anouska Callender (2nd)** and **Emily Goddard (3rd)**.

In the Under 9 age group **Rachelle Rogers** (Wycombe) triumphed, and **Zak Jesse** (Aldershot) was fastest boy. Other gold medal winners of the day were **Alessia Thomas-Jackson** (Beckton), **Frankie Simmonds** (Wycombe), **Nicola Wilson** (Chatham), **Emily Goddard** (Wycombe), **Kirsty Stevens** (Bromley) **Katy Lamb** (Escapees) and **Mary Ondrusz** (Bromley). In the male category **Thomas Kirton** (Chatham), **Joe Ogden** (Wycombe), **Harrison Bolt** (Aldershot), **Jack Buchanan** (Bromley), **Marc Telling** (Wycombe), **Paul Telling** (Wycombe) and **Pete Jesse** (Aldershot) all scooped the gold's.

The final event of the day was the dual slalom race. The Club event provided some very competitive and exciting skiing with Wycombe A narrowly beating Bromley A with Bromley B team securing 3rd place. The 5 races, sponsored by SkiBartlett of Hillingdon, form a league with the best 3 results counting towards final rankings.

Paul Telling has already won his age category but skiers in all categories will be competing in earnest at the last 2 races at Chatham (31 August) and Aldershot (21 September) to gain the extra points needed to improve their rankings.
