The European Championships held at Wycombe Summit Ski Centre in July plus the Inter-Regional at Pendle have seen our racers on the Podium again.

At the Europeans the females did very well with Anouska Callander coming 2<sup>nd</sup> overall (1<sup>st</sup> JN2) and Charlotte Evans right behind in 3<sup>rd</sup> place overall (2<sup>nd</sup> CH2) less than 1½ seconds behind the winner Jayme Baggio. Others who did well included Kathryn Barber 6<sup>th</sup> overall (3<sup>rd</sup> JN1) and Gemma Duckett 10<sup>th</sup> overall (5<sup>th</sup> JN1). In the younger age groups LSERSA skiers excelled with Emily Evans winning her age group closely followed by Charlotte Jesse.

Sarah Thornton (Natives), who only started racing this season, managed a 5<sup>th</sup> place in the senior category.

The men were as good with Marc Telling taking 2<sup>nd</sup> place overall (1<sup>st</sup> senior male) closely followed by Oliver Robinson in 3<sup>rd</sup> place (2<sup>nd</sup> JN2). Daniel Curtis managed 2<sup>nd</sup> place in CH2 category whilst David Askew took 1<sup>st</sup> place again in the CH1 group.. Peter Davies came a close 3<sup>rd</sup> CH1. Our masters did exceptionally well with James Gambrill (Natives) and Paul Bunton (Chatham) taking 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> place behind Marcus Perner one of the Austrian guests.

At the InterRegional in Pendle our team managed 3<sup>rd</sup> place on the podium. The team comprised Franki Simmonds, Kathryn Barber, Paul Telling, Lloyd Papanтониou, Marc Telling, Joe Oden and Ben Clark.

## **RACE OFFICIALS COURSE**
