



**INTER-REGIONAL RACE SERIES  
XSCAPE, Milton Keynes  
18<sup>th</sup> MAY 2003**



**ENTRY SPECIFICATIONS**

Each Region will be invited to enter teams of 12 racers to take part in the first Inter-Regional Race at Milton Keynes on 18<sup>th</sup> May 2003.

Racers in the Regional teams must have their first named club as a club within that Region and racers cannot be substituted on the day of the race with a racer from any other Region.

There will be four races in the series and racers picked for their Regional Team in the first race on 18<sup>th</sup> May will not be eligible for the second race in August 2003. This is intended for the development of racers within the Regions to give the opportunity to more racers to compete on snow.

The race in October (Race Series 3) will be for skiers not entered in the first two races, i.e. probably skiers with little or no experience of racing. This may include skiers not already registered as racers, but must be members of a club affiliated to that Region.

The final race in November will again be the Regional “A” squads to compete.

These races are not individual events, although the racers will ski against the clock for individual times. The top seven finishers from each Region will give a combined time for the Team results at each race. Points will be awarded from these results to the Regions which will accumulate over the four races.

**RACE 1 – 18<sup>th</sup> May 2003 Milton Keynes, XSCAPE**

Teams of 12 skiers from each of the 9 Regions

Teams of 12 skiers invited from Wales and Scotland (each classed as a separate Region for this event)

Team of 12 skiers from XSCAPE

**RACE 2 – August 2003 (date as in race calendar, but to be confirmed)**

Teams as above, but not the same skiers who entered the race on 18<sup>th</sup> May.

This is intended for the Development squads of the Regions

**RACE 3 – October 2003 (date as in race calendar, but to be confirmed)**

Teams as above intended for skiers with little or no race experience on snow.

Preferably not including any skier who has already competed in race 2 above, but definitely not from race 1.

**RACE 4 – November 2003 (hopefully at the new Xscape centre, in Castleford M62)**

Teams of 12 – intended to the “A” squads from the Regions to battle for the overall team results.

These races are in the above format to encourage each Region to build Regional teams from grass root skiing to top level.
