Every attempt will be made to keep to the stated times. However, organisers reserve the right to change the programme, as necessary.

RACE RULES

The race will be run under F.I.S. rules as varied by E.S.C. Your attention is drawn to Occasional Alpine Racing bulletin 2002, which details current regulations, particularly with regard to equipment and course inspection, available on www.britski.org.

TDs have been instructed to apply the unsportsmanlike behaviour rule to any racer using bad language.

This will result in sanctions, ultimately leading to bans for repeated offences.

Ski binding max heights, Ch1 45mm, Ch2 50mm, Jun/Sen 55mm. All competitors must wear a properly fitting FIS approved safety helmet during training and competitions. Gloves and long sleeves must be worn at all times whilst on the slope including during open practice, course inspection and the race itself. Racers inspecting the course must wear skis.

and carry/wear bibs with number clearly visible. No one is allowed to ski the course during inspection.

Coaches may accompany their racers on skis, as long as they carry the relevant accreditation.

AWARDS

The fastest seven skiers from each Region will count towards the Team scores

(all 12 members of the team will receive a medal if their team is 1st, 2nd or 3rd.)

COMMENTATOR SHEETS & RACE BIBS

Commentator sheets must be completed and handed in when collecting a race bib. Race bibs must be returned to the Finish Marshall on completion of the second run. Failure to do so will result in a charge of £25 for each missing bib.
