### Race Bulletin No. 1 and Acceptance List

#### Organisation

The event is being organised by Bromley Ski Club on behalf of the English Ski Council.

#### Entry Criteria

The Club National event is a special slalom of 3 runs down the same course, and is open to registered racers in the following categories: Children I, Children II, Junior I, Junior II, Senior and Masters. Racers with no seed points are given priority over those with seed points. The Mini's race follows the same format, and is open to registered racers born in 1993-1996.

If the race entry does not reach 170 registered racers then non registered racers may enter the race provided an extra fee of £2.50 is paid to cover the cost of insurance i.e. total entry cost £16.50

Any entries received and accepted after the closing date will be subject to an additional fee of £5.00

Every attempt will be made to keep to the stated times, but the organisers reserve the right to change the times if necessary. Please check the race notice board on arrival and listen out for announcements over the PA system.

#### Race Rules

The race will be run under FIS rules as varied by the ESC. The last run will be in reverse time order based on the best time from the first two runs. The result will be based on the best time from the first two runs plus the time from the third.

The Start Referee has the right to refuse a racer starting if the racer does not appear on time. The Start Referee will be instructed to work to FIS 613.6.

Gloves and long sleeves must be worn at all times whilst on the slope, including during open practice, course inspection and the race itself.

Racers are reminded of the regulations requiring the use of protective 'bungs' or caps on ski pole tips, of the regulations governing the limits on ski binding height. These regulations are liable to be enforced during this event.

**For this Race whilst skiing through the poles all competitors and forerunners must wear head protection complying with BS EN1385 or equivalent.**

### Course Inspection

The course must be inspected wearing skis, and bibs numbers must be visible throughout course inspection. No-one is allowed to ski the course during inspection. Race trainers/coaches may accompany their racers and do not now need to wear skis unless the slope rules insist. Course inspection may start from any point on the course.

Masters racers please note that they are not eligible for prizes in the Senior age group. For the purposes of Club National races, Seniors and Masters are designated as separate age groups.

The winners will be expected to show due courtesy to the organisers by attending the prize giving. Those who do not attend without good reason lose their claim to an award.

### Acceptance

Minutes of the first jury meeting held on Saturday 21st June. Valid entries were received from 9 Girls, 16 Boys, 38 Females and 83 Males. All entries were accepted.

As the race is under subscribed at this time the jury decided to produce an acceptance list, the start list will be drawn using Seed List 2003.2 at the next jury meeting and displayed on the official notice board on the morning of the race

Entries from racers with a note by their name on the enclosed start list were provisionally accepted, and must see the Race Secretary on race day to validate their entry prior to collecting their bib. Notes are as follows:

S requires the entry form to be signed.

P requires payment / payment adjustment of £14.00 race entry fee.

R requires proof of registration

### Late entries

The jury will consider late entries (up to a maximum of 170 racers) received by Tuesday 1<sup>st</sup> July 2003

### **Protests, and late entry acceptance confirmation**

Protests against non-acceptance of entries must be received in writing by the Race Secretary by 1st post Tuesday 1<sup>st</sup> July 2003. Results of protests, and confirmation of acceptance of late entries may be obtained by phoning the Race Secretary Sally Woods on 01634 362174 between 8pm and 9pm on Wednesday 2<sup>nd</sup> July 2003

### **Race office and Notice board**

The race office will be at the Race Secretary's address until the evening of Friday 4<sup>th</sup> July 2003 and will be located at Chatham Ski Centre from 08.30 Saturday 5<sup>th</sup> July 2003. The official race notice board will be located under the stairs on the patio at the Ski Centre.

### **Commentator sheets and race bibs**

Commentator sheets must be completed and handed in when collecting a race bib. Race bibs must be returned to the Finish Marshall on completion of the final run, and failure to do so will result in a charge of £25 for each missing bib.

### **Referee's Report Protests**

Referee's Report protests must be made in writing on official forms, which will be available at the race office. These must be completed and handed in within the set time limit, and accompanied by a fee of £25.

### **Open Practice**

Chatham Ski Centre will be open for practice on Friday until 10.00pm charges for a one and a half hour session are £7.00 for children and £9.50 for adults

### **First Aid**

First Aid will be supplied by Chatham Ski Centre Staff.

### **Dope Testing**

Dope testing may take place at this event.

### **Regulations**

Racers are reminded of the following

1. Ski Poles with a tip diameter of less than 15mm must be fitted with suitable tip protectors to increase the tip diameter to 15 mm.
2. Bad Language – TD's have been instructed to apply the unsportsmanlike behavior rule to any racer using bad language. This will result in sanctions ultimately leading to bans for repeated offenders.
3. Ski Binding Heights, Children 1 - 45mm Max, Children 2 - 50mm Max, Junior / Seniors 55mm Max.
4. **For this Race whilst skiing through the poles all competitors and forerunners must wear head protection complying with BS EN1385 or equivalent.**
5. Start Licenses may be checked.
6. All racers are advised to read the revised ROTP race manual- a copy can be found on Peter Heath's web site ([britski.org](http://britski.org)).

### **Refunds**

Following acceptance into the race, refunds of £10 will only be given to racers on production of a medical certificate.

### **Spectators**

Racers and spectators are requested to ensure that the area at the top of the counter-slope in front of the safety netting is kept clear of people and equipment at all times.
