### RACE FORMAT for 2006 RACE SERIES

- It was agreed to maintain the race format for LSERSA Regional races at 3 runs. Results will be determined by the best of the first two runs plus the last run.
- Racers will ski in the same order (reverse Bib number order) for all three runs.
- Bib order will be determined by the order of receipt of entries except that the first 15 will be randomly selected to prevent the same person having the advantage of skiing last (bib 1) in all races.
- The dual slalom will aim to be run as leagues, with racers skiing all teams in their league. The organisers reserve the right to change this format at an event to either a knock out, or to cancel the dual slalom, for example: if there are adverse weather conditions or time constraints.
- Timetable of the day to change to:

0830 hours	Race office opens for bib issue / Open Practice
0930 hours	Course setting
0950 hours	Course inspection
1015 hours	Start of First Run of Special Slalom Race
PM	Team races start
- Registration will close at 7.00 pm on the Wednesday preceding each race.
- The start list will be published on the website on the Friday before each race.
- Late entries will be accepted, subject to the race not being oversubscribed (limit to be set by the race committee), with a penalty being payable. Race day entries will cost £20.00.
- All skiers are welcome to participate regardless of the region they are registered with and will be eligible to win medals for individual races.
- All entrants will be eligible for the end of season overall positions and medals. A minimum of 3 races must be successfully finished to gain sufficient points towards the end of season award. The best 3 races to count, with other races being used to determine placings in the event of a tie.
- Race entry fees to remain the same for single entry; i.e. £13.50, with 5 races for the price £55.00 if skiers pay for the whole series by 7.00pm on the Wednesday before the first race.
