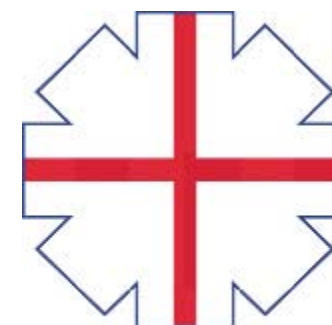

## RACE ENTRY DETAILS

To participate in the 10<sup>th</sup> English Alpine Championships, British competitors must be registered with their Home Nation.  
All competitors must have a current insurance policy that permits them to ski race. The Race organizers will require proof of insurance such as a valid governing body race licence or an independent certificate of insurance.

All Jun/Sen. racers are reminded that they must be FIS registered to take part in these championships. Jun/Sen. racers without a valid FIS number will not be accepted. Applications for the appropriate licence should be made direct to Snowsport GB as soon as possible and at least 3 weeks prior to the closing date.

Competitors in the Minis races must have either signed the Snowsport GB Athlete's Declaration or be registered with their Home Nation Governing Body and have appropriate insurance.

The Organising Committee reserves the right to refuse entry to skiers who do not possess seed points and who cannot demonstrate a minimum level of competence. Suitable evidence may include previous race results or a Coach's certification.

All British entries must be made on the official entry form, one per competitor and will only be accepted if accompanied by the correct race entry fee of:  
CH/Junior/senior £30.00 per competitor per discipline.  
Minis entry fee is £15.00 per competitor per race.

Non-British FIS entries should be made on the appropriate National Ski Federation FIS entry forms in accordance with FIS regulations. Non-British CH/Mini's use the standard entry form

Cheques must be made payable to: Snowsport England Alpine Championships and sent to the race secretary, Mandy Orrell, 53 Dorset Street, Rosegrove, Burnley, Lancs, BB12 6HS

Refunds Due to the enormous cost in organising these Championships, there will be no refund of race entry fees made available after the race entry has been accepted, even if one or more races are cancelled.

### THE CLOSING DATE IS FRIDAY 10TH MARCH 2006

An acceptance list will be published on the [www.britski.org](http://www.britski.org) website by Friday 17<sup>th</sup> March 2006. NB. This will not be updated with late entries.

### Late entries will incur a penalty of £20.00 per competitor per race.

Acceptance of entries in the resort will be dependent on the entries already received and the snow conditions. Competitors are therefore warned that their presence in the resort will not necessarily gain them entry into the races.

Resort entries should be handed into the race office between 15.00h and 16.00h on Saturday 1<sup>st</sup> April 2006, a final decision will be available by 18.00h.

Individual prizes will be awarded to the first three racers in each discipline and in the following categories. Masters, Senior, Junior 2, Junior 1, Children 2, Children 1 and Minis.

The award of English Champion 2006 will be made in accordance with Snowsport England rules.

Club prizes will be awarded to the first three Snowsport England registered clubs and the first non-registered club.

Additional medals for the FIS races will be made immediately after each race at the bottom of the race piste.
