## Bromley Club National and Minis' Race

**Venue:** Bromley Ski Centre, Sandy Lane, St Paul's Cray, Orpington BR5 3HY  
**Race Date:** Sunday 19<sup>th</sup> April 2009

### Race Bulletin No. 1 (Invite)

#### Organisation

The event is being organised by Bromley Race Club on behalf of Snowsport England and is open to all registered and non registered racers (subject to an additional fee of £5.00 for public liability insurance and administration).

#### Entry Criteria

The Club National event is a special slalom of 3 runs down the same course, and is open to registered racers in the following categories: Children I, Children II, Junior I, Junior II, Senior and Masters. Racers with no seed points are given priority over those with seed points and unregistered racers in the event of the race being oversubscribed. The Minis' race follows the same format, and is open to registered racers born in 1999, 2000, 2001 and 2002.

Every attempt will be made to keep to the stated times, but the organisers reserve the right to change the times if necessary.

#### Race Rules/Health and Safety

The race will be run in accordance with FIS ICR as varied by BACR (British Artificial Competition Rules). The first and second runs will be in bib order and the last run will be in reverse time order based on the best time from the first two runs. The result will be based on the best time from the first two runs plus the time from the third. All runs will be down the same course. Racers will be required to wear a helmet, gloves, long trousers and a long sleeved garment, which also covers the midriff, to reduce the risk of injury, at all times whilst on the slope, including during open practice and course inspection during the race.

No ski preparation/spraying is to take place within the start area. No smoking is allowed in the start area or on the slope. To comply with Health and Safety within the slope NO PERSONAL COOKING EQUIPMENT OR BBQs will be allowed. You are not allowed to use any electrical socket outlets without the permission of the slope.

#### Course Inspection

The course must be inspected wearing skis and bibs must be worn correctly throughout course inspection. No one is allowed to ski the course during inspection. Accredited Race trainers/Coaches may accompany their racers.

## Refunds

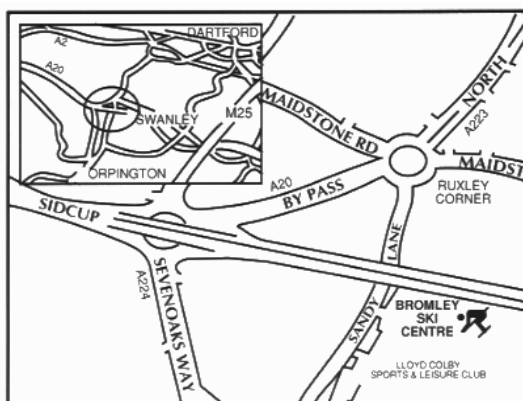
Following acceptance into the race, refunds of £10 will only be given to racers on production of a medical certificate.
